TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP (Students or Parents Only):

1. Contact the PFA Administration Office and complete an application for the appropriate scholarship or fund.
2. The PFA Administration Scholarship and Endowment Committee will review all requests and submit their recommendation to the PFA Foundation Inc., as recommended by the Foundation's representative on the Scholarship and Endowment Committee.
3. The Foundation will review the recommendations for awarding student scholarships based on the work of the Committee.
4. If the recommendation for an award is approved, the PFA Foundation will notify the PFA Administration of the award and will send a check directly to the PFA Administration for deposit into the students' account.
5. The Foundation will notify in writing to the benefactor the award of the scholarship and the PFA Principal will notify the student and the parent where appropriate of the credit into the students' account.
6. Appropriate recognition, per the benefactor's requirements, will be honored as stated.
7. **All questions from the application should be directed to the PFA Administration Office and not to the PFA Foundation Office.**

Note: *The PFA Foundation does not accept scholarship applications. All requests or applications must be submitted to the PFA Administration Office or the Principal's Office. Applications sent to the Foundation will be returned – no exceptions.*

TO ESTABLISH AN ANNUALLY FUNDED SCHOLARSHIP FUND:

1. You can establish an annual scholarship fund for as little as \$250, plus a one-time set-up fee of \$25 to cover administrative maintenance and support.
2. Simply go to the PFA Foundation website at www.pfafoundation.org and download the forms to establish the scholarship.
3. Send in the form with a check for at least \$1,000, plus the one-time set-up of \$25 and the scholarship will be opened within five business days. Also, forms can be faxed or mailed by calling the PFA Foundation office at (216) 851-1018 and the fax number is (216) 851-1020. Mail all forms to: Pine Forge Academy Foundation, Inc., 540 East 105th Street, Suite 245, Cleveland, Ohio 44108, Attention: Office Manager.
4. You will receive a written acknowledgement of the fund and receive an annual report on the balance in your fund.
5. You can contribute to your fund at any time by: mail, online, or by phone.
6. Our automatic online payment systems allow you to manage your account, get an up to the minute history of your account and enable you to make additional payments.

TO ESTABLISH AN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND:

1. You can establish an endowment fund for as little as \$1,000, plus a one-time nominal set up fee of \$25. The fund must reach a balance of at least \$10,000 within five years of the date of establishing the fund.
2. You can establish an endowment **In Honor Of** or **In Memory Of** a special person, group or organization.
3. Simply go to the PFA Foundation website at www.pfafoundation.org and download the forms to establish the endowment. Forms can also be faxed or mailed by calling the PFA Foundation office at (216) 851-1018.
4. Submit the completed forms with a check for at least \$1,000, plus the set up fee of \$25 and the endowment fund will be opened within five business days.
5. You will receive a written acknowledgement of the fund and will receive an annual report on the balance in your fund, expenses and any changes in balances due to withdrawals, credits for earnings or fees assessed.
6. You can contribute to your fund at any time by: mail, online, or by phone.
7. Our online donor management systems allow you to manage your account, to get an up to the minute history of your account and to make additional payments according to your individualized payment schedule.

8. The Foundation will assess an annual fee of \$25 for all endowed funds to cover financial management fees by the financial advisors and other operating costs.
9. A benefactor may begin to award a scholarship from your fund at any time, but the fund balance must be a minimum of at least five years of annual awards or a minimum balance of at least \$1,000 in the fund balance, whichever is the lowest, at all times to make the minimum amount of the annual award.
10. Note: Withdrawals may require additional contributions to the fund in order to reach the \$10,000 limit within five years. If the fund does not reach \$10,000 within the five years from the date of inception of the fund, the Foundation may award the balance of the funds, transfer the funds to an existing fund or closeout the fund.
